HOW TO BECOME A BOOK REVIEWER FOR AMAZON* IN NINE EASY STEPS

Here's the definitive guide to adding a book review on Amazon.

- 1. First, you need to be on Amazon's webpage for the book. The easiest way to find it is to sign into Amazon and type "Bucknoll" into the search box. If you ordered the book through Amazon then you can also go to Your Orders and find it there. Or try this!
- Once you're on the page for *The Bucknoll Cottage Chronicles*, scroll down, down, down past Editorial Reviews and Product Details, past About the Author (where you can opt to follow my anticks) to **Customer Reviews**.
- 3. On the right side of this section are customer reviews received so far. You might want to skim these to see what others are saying. Feel free to click the HELPFUL button under reviews you feel merit this.
- 4. In the left-side column there's a box that says **Write a customer** review. Click it!
- 5. Select a Star Rating. Technically you can stop right there but it would be great if you would consider adding comments.
- 6. To write a review:

Create a Headline. This could be a call to action ("For a good laugh read this book!" "Learn a thing or two about second homes") or you could repeat a line from your review. Statements (like "Best Book I Read All Year") also work.

*NOTA BENE: Only customers who have spent at least \$50 on Amazon in the previous 12 months are able to leave a Customer Review.

Add your review. This is where you say what you liked (or didn't like) about the book. As your 5th grade teacher probably told you, start by summarizing what it's about and mention a chapter or two that you liked a lot. If you're stumped, you could refer to one of the other reviews posted and say you agree with it. Details you might add: You might note that you read these stories previously on mylittlebird.com but they take on a new meaning when put together in book form. Or . . .you could (but don't have to) say you know the place where these stories happened, or even know the author. Up to you.

- 7. If you plan to add a lengthy commentary, I'd advise writing it in your word processing program first and then cutting and pasting it into the space. This way you can edit your comments offline and put them through spell check, etc.
- 8. At the very top of the section just above "CREATE REVIEW" you can change your name to a pseudonym, or publish under your own name!
- 9. If you like what you wrote, click **Submit**. A green check mark shows for successfully submitted ratings.
